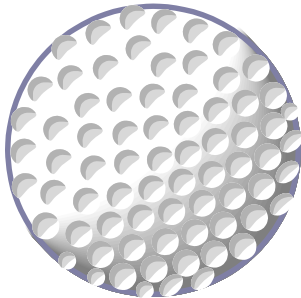

HONOUR YOUR PARENTS
